

TEA ROOM NEWS.

You will have heard that The Tea Room at The Coimín Centre is changing. The in-house bakery and café style operation was not proving financially sound for the parish. The Coimín Management Committee wish to acknowledge the feedback from customers who would like to see the continuation of Tea Room service in some fashion. The Tea Room has proved to be a valuable community amenity. We have bright comfortable facilities, an ideal venue for all to meet, catch up and enjoy company.

What we need is your help and support to reimagine and grow a refreshment service in a suitable and sustainable way.

Since the start of May this year when changes were introduced, we have maintained a coffee service Monday – Friday with the support of Tús staff member and volunteers. From the 8th of June we anticipate reduced Tús staff availability and volunteer support due to holidays etc. Therefore, the Tea Room will take a break from Friday 8th June.

Our opening plans for September onwards will depend on your response and actions.

Please contact the Parish Office if you would like to be involved in Parish activities in any of the following ways.

Training and support will be provided.

1. Volunteer as a Tea Room assistant: Duties include basic kitchen operations and tea and coffee service.
2. Volunteer as a kitchen assistant to support Day Care meal provision (Wednesdays or Thursdays).
3. Volunteer with tea /coffee service for Parish social functions / events / funerals.
4. Volunteer home baked goods for supply to Tea Room service.
5. Assist with fundraising.
